Apply for your Student Visa with Immigration NZ (ImmigrationOnline)

- 1. Create your Immigration ONLINE account via www.immigration.govt.nz/study

- 2. Complete your visa application online and upload the required documents as listed below.

01	PERSONAL DETAILS A Passport size photograph (not more than 6 months old) B Passport must be valid for at least 3 months after expected visa end date C Valid current visa	
02	STUDENT PERFORMANCE (NON PHD STUDENTS) A Study history report can be downloaded from: Massey student portal > Results and exams > Academic Records B Pre-degree student only - attendance record from Massey University College	
03	ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS (PHD STUDENTS) A Doctoral confirmation letter (supervisor's letter) – include supervisor name/s and contact details, thesis title, expected submission date & completion date (6 months after thesis submission). Submit your request via the Research Details tab. B Latest 6 month progress report C Thesis proposal D CV or resume	0 00
04	CONFIRMATION OF ENROLMENT Confirmation of Enrolment can be downloaded from: Massey student portal > Home / All messages	
05	TUITION FEES PAYMENT A Paid your university fees for the next one year, or one qualification, whichever is shorter * OR if Scholarship or Fed Aid loan, include this letter together with the Statement of Account. B Statement of Account can be downloaded from: Massey student portal > Fees & Finance > download statement. * PhD student only - Tuition fees must be paid for the length of the visa applied for. You can pay your fees due via your Massey Student Portal using your credit card. If you are renewing before 1 October and are seeking a length of visa for the next academic year, you can pay the estimated year of fees via bank transfer (ensure you provide your student ID on the reference) or at Campus Information Services. Use this year's tuition fees as a guideline to calculate your estimated future annual fee.	
06	FUNDS FOR LIVING COSTS You need to provide evidence that you have enough money to live on while you're studying in New Zealand. Your personal bank statement is to be printed <u>after</u> paying your fees, and not more than 2 days before you lodge your visa application: A bank transaction details for the last 6 months which includes: i Bank logo and bank name ii Student full name and account details B show sufficient funds for living cost plus outbound flight cost: iii \$20,000 per year (\$1,667 minimum per month for the intended length of time to stay) AND iv \$1,500 or return air ticket. OR attach evidence of: Financial Undertaking INZ1014 / Sponsorship INZ1025 / Scholarship / Fed Aid loan. Include foreign bank accounts, if applicable.	
07	GENERAL REQUIREMENTS International Student Medical and Travel Insurance is required until completion of studies or visa expiry whichever is later Full medical/chest X-ray is required every 36 months Home country police certificate is required every 36 months
