Welcome to the Massey Manawatu Halls!


ACCOMMODATION INFORMATION:

At Campus Living Villages we endeavor to provide you with quality accommodation facilities to suit all requirements.

In each hall you will find a large common room with full kitchen facilities, a comfortable lounge and dining area, wall mounted plasma screen television with Sky TV and dvd access, a computer lab and full laundry facilities. Bathroom facilities are communal; however offer secure and private cubicles.

Each superior bedroom contains a king single bed and bed linen (sheets, pillow, duvet and blanket) and towel, a wardrobe and small set of drawers, a study desk and chair, shelving, heating and an internet portal connection along with a towel and soap provided on arrival.

We have 100 superior bedrooms available in Matai & Totara Hall (50 in each hall) with the following configurations:

Here at the Massey Manawatu Halls we have available an onsite catering service operated by Alliance Catering. We are able to offer all meals including continental and cooked breakfasts, packed lunches, dinner and desserts.

FACILITIES:

Kanuka Common – offers a comfortable lounge with plasma screen television with Sky TV and dvd access.

Kanuka Computer Lab- Computers and printers available for use, internet access will need a massey logon.

Kanuka Laundry facilities – Washing machines and dryer available for use free of charge.

Matai/Totara Kitchen facilities – full kitchen facilities with basic cooking and cutlery utensils, tea, coffee, sugar and milk provided. Stove, oven, fridge, toaster, sandwich press and boiling water tap all available for use.

Telephone calls:

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

Tentative booking

Campus Living Villages will tentatively reserve your accommodation booking for a maximum of 30 days after which if written confirmation and deposit is not received, we reserve the right to release your booking.

Confirmation and deposit

Confirmation of your booking must be placed by completing the attached reservation confirmation document, along with a 1 night's accommodation deposit. Deposits are refundable if in accordance with the cancellation policies.

Final payment

Final payment representing the total cost less the deposit is due before arrival unless by prior arrangement an extension is accepted. Check in will not be accepted and keys not allocated until final payment has been made.

Occupancy

Final occupancy numbers and dates must be notified five working days prior to accommodation arrival. Any reduction in occupancy following the notification of final numbers will be subject to charge at the full nightly rate as per the cancellation policies.

Room assignment

Contact names, email addresses and phone numbers of all persons residing in the halls must be provided to our office **at least five working days** prior to arrival. Rooms will be allocated at our discretion unless specific allotments are requested. Please advise at the time of booking if specific allotments will be required.

Preventing damage

Each room occupant is financially responsible for all damage sustained to the room during their stay. The occupant will be individually billed for this damage and given 30 days to make payment. For all communal damage done to the halls all occupants will be held liable if no ownership is taken and will be billed accordingly with 30 days to make payment.

Occupants are responsible for their room keys; keys lost will incur a \$160-00 charge. The occupant will be individually billed for this loss and given 30 days to make payment.

All damage/lost keys that have not been paid within 30 days of departure will be billed to the conference organizers.

Cancellation

We will be disappointed if you do need to cancel your accommodation however we do realize that this is sometimes unpreventable. If cancelling accommodation the following policies apply:-

0 – 5 Working Days

If cancellation occurs within 5 working days of arrival the deposit paid will be forfeited.

5 – 10 Working Days

If cancellation occurs within 5 - 10 working days of arrival 50% of the deposit will be forfeited. Please contact our office to arrange 50% credit.

10+ Working Days

If cancellation occurs with more than 10 days' notice your deposit is fully refundable, please contact our office to arrange for credit.
