
WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY: LEADING ISSUES

We're delighted to announce a MPOWER seminar on leading workplace health and safety issues and developments, with the following speakers:

Ian Laird is Associate Professor in Occupational Health and Safety in the School of Public Health at Massey University, Palmerston North. He has served on many government committees, and has provided advice on occupational health to the Ministers of Health and Labour. Currently, Ian is a member of the Occupational Health Advisory Group, which advises the Board of Worksafe NZ. Ian leads the Occupational Health and Safety programme at Massey University and is a Fulbright Fellow and Visiting Scientist at the Harvard School of Public Health.



David Tappin is senior lecturer in the School of Management and a member of the Healthy Work Group at Massey University. Before joining Massey in 2011, he was a researcher with Scion (a crown research institute), and prior to this, a co-director of the consultancy and research company SPE Ltd. Most of his time in these roles has involved injury prevention research and consultancy in primary industries, primary processing, manufacturing and residential construction. David's current research focuses on the reduction of psychosocial risks in work and the development of sustainable work.



Deirdre Farr is assistant lecturer in the School of Management at Massey University, Palmerston North. She has co-authored in peer reviewed journals and presented at international conferences, and is a member of Massey's Employment Research Group. She worked as a Health and Safety Analyst in the forestry industry before embarking on her PhD. Her PhD case study research is examining *how statutory provisions are contributing to employee engagement, participation and representation in the high-risk construction industry?*
