Geology Field School Liability Waiver

I,, understand that Geology Field Camp (233.302E1 and 233.203E1) is a required course for the benefit of my education as a geology or geophysics major. I understand that the work to be done in the geology field course involves an element of risk. This risk includes, but is not limited to, mapping and measuring geologic formations in rugged and remote terrain, and that I will have to exercise extreme caution to avoid falls that are likely to injure me.
