


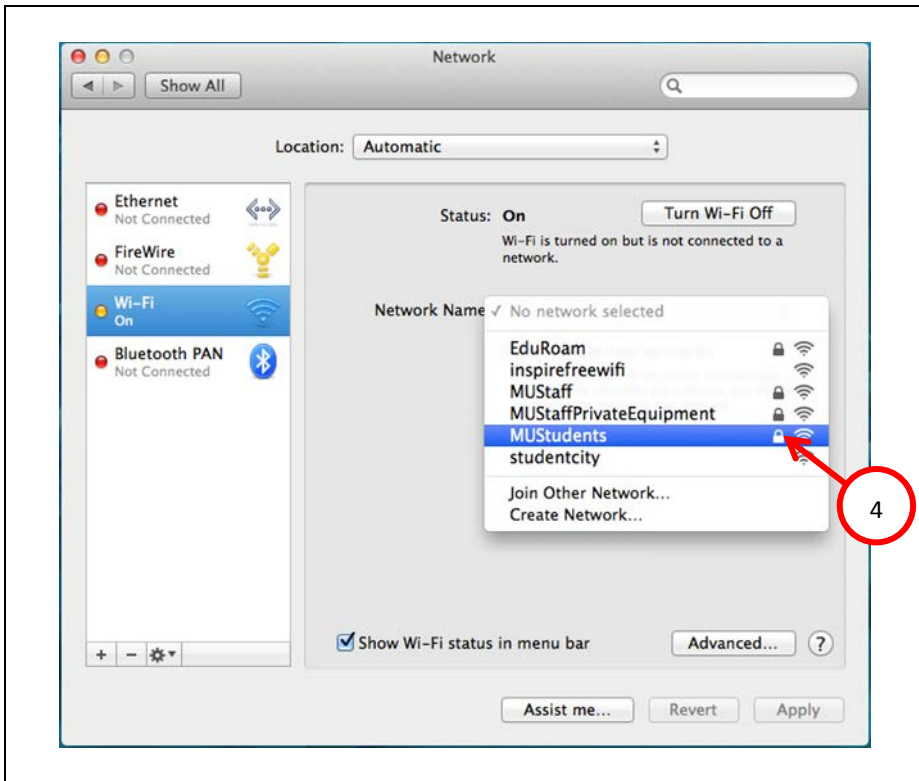

	<p>1. Click on the Wi-Fi icon (previously called Airport) in the Menu Bar.</p>
	<p>2. Select Open Network Preferences...</p>
	<p>3. Click on Wi-Fi (or Airport)</p>




4. Select the Wireless network to connect, there are many Massey wireless networks available:

- **MUStudents** - Student users on any equipment
- **MUStaffPrivateEquipment** - Staff using private or non-Massey equipment
- **MUStaff** - Staff using Massey-managed equipment (those with an ITXXXXXX number)

A dialog box will open asking for a username and password to connect to Wireless Network




5. Enter your Massey Student ID and password, and click **Join**



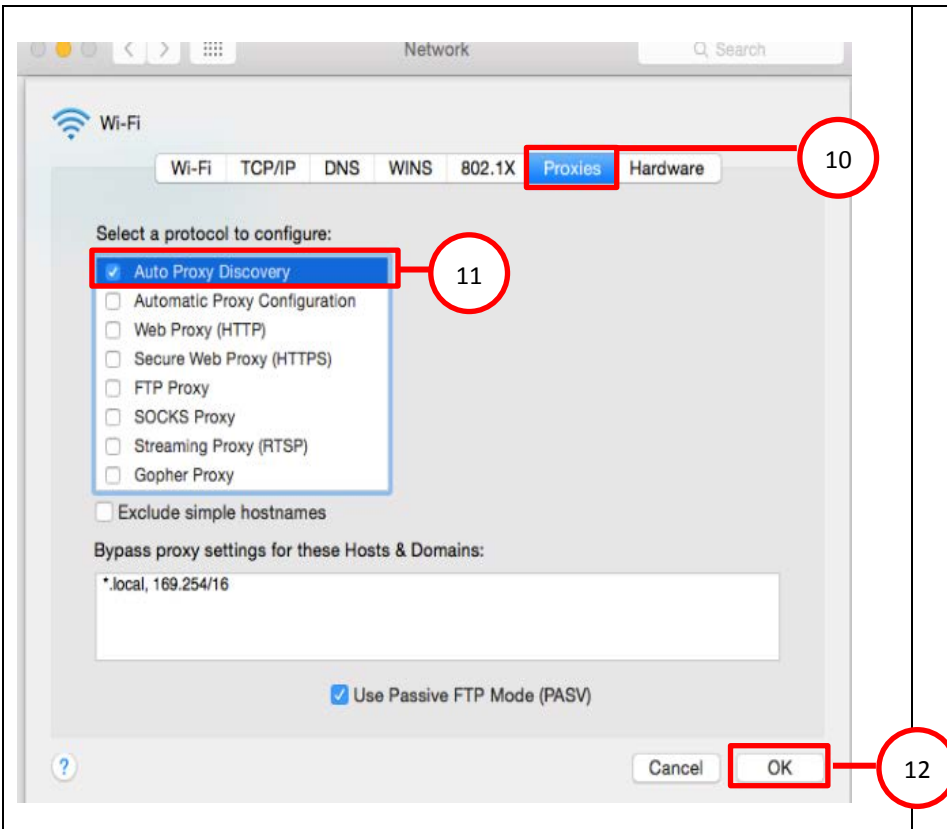
6. Ensure **Wi-Fi** (previously named Airport) is **On** and connected.

7. Check that the correct wireless network is selected. For student (**MUSStudents**) and for Staff (**MUStaff**) and for Staff personal computer (**MUStaffPrivateEquipment**)

8. Ensure the connection has been authenticated.



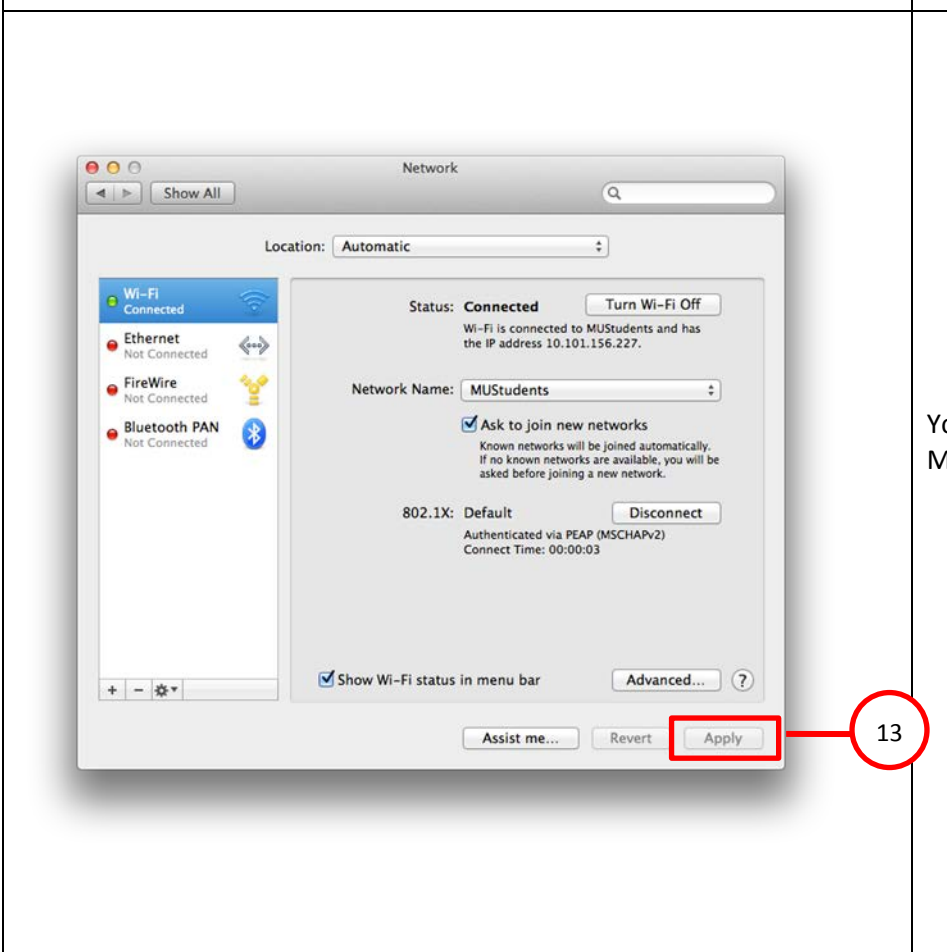
9. In the Network Window, click on **Advanced**.



10. Click on the **Proxies** tab.

11. Tick box for “**Auto Proxy Discovery**”.

12. Click on OK.



13. Click Apply to the **Network Window**.

You should now be connected to the Massey network.
