- The first day will involve an orientation to the accommodation, local area, and the internship programme
- All students will stay together in a backpackers hostel style residence, with shared cooking/bathroom facilities
- Students complete an intensive programme of online coursework over the four week programme
- All students have access to Massey University Wellington campus facilities including library and student health. The National Expedition and Internship Programme Coordinators are based at Massey's Wellington campus and will be available to assist you throughout your placement
- Weekdays: The students will commute to their host organizations for their internships, which run Monday through Friday approximately from 9:00am to 5:00pm. Each week the students, academic coordinator and programme staff will meet for a review of the internships.
- Weekends: 5:00pm on Friday through 9:00pm on Sunday is free for study or personal travel. Students leaving Wellington are required to notify their Programme Coordinator at least 24 hours in advance and provide the details of their itinerary in writing. Interns are expected to be fit for work during the week and not to make travel arrangements that could negatively impact their ability to contribute to their placement (e.g. late travels on Sunday evening).
