Purpose:

The purpose of this Policy is to support a coordinated approach to the planning and delivery of Summer School offerings.

Policy:

The purposes of Summer School offerings are to enhance the ability of students to plan their programmes and to support student progression through qualifications. When planning for the delivery of Summer School offerings, priority will be given to those papers or short courses that provide an opportunity for the following areas (listed in no particular order):

- accelerated progression through a qualification e.g., for Masters qualifications of more than one year, offerings may be made available that afford students the opportunity to complete their programme in a shorter time;
- developing foundation or entry-level skills that prepare students for success in their first full academic year;
- providing additional opportunities for profitable full cost recovery professional and continuing education courses;
- taking advantage of seasonal patterns for the purposes of distance learning, internships, intensive or practice-based learning, fieldwork, and other forms of work-integrated learning;
- facilitating the study of minors across Colleges.

Offerings that are not consistent with the above criteria will require the approval of the relevant Pro Vice-Chancellor (or delegate).
