

FIRST AIDER TRAINING

Has our Department trained enough First Aiders?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The University requires a minimum 10% of staff to be qualified first aiders. This percentage is also recommended by the Department of Labour where access to medical services may be restricted.	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A person qualified in first aid must be available during all working hours, particularly in student laboratories or on field trips where access to other first aid personnel may not be readily available.	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Where there are significant risks (e.g. hazardous substances, dangerous tools or equipment, isolated work areas etc) then you need to assess this risk and determine if additional first aiders and/or first aid provisions will be required.• In determining who should be trained, consider also issues such as shift work, out of normal hours work, access to emergency services, student numbers, the need for travel, how fragmented the work area is, etc
