Paid the university fees, payment receipt, scholarship letter, financial guarantee, or loan confirmation

- INZ1025 Sponsorship Form if sponsor has New Zealand PR or Citizenship and lives in New Zealand if it is approved by INZ previously.

New students from other institution and PaCE pathway students:

PLEASE NOTE

1 LENGTH OF STUDENT VISA

- Massey University will apply for a student visa in agreement with the tuition fees that you have paid, and the sufficient living costs for the same period of time that you can provide, as long as adequate academic progress is maintained. For example, if you have paid for one semester's tuition fees, provided evidence of one semester's living costs, and passed 75% of your previous semester's study, then you may receive a one semester visa. If you have paid for one year's tuition fees, provided evidence of one year's living costs, and passed 75% of your previous year's study, then you may receive a one year visa.

2 APPLICATION REFUND POLICY

- If a visa application is rejected by Immigration after being processed by this office, only the Immigration New Zealand visa cost will be refunded.
