

Our mission: to empower Pasifika students and communities to achieve their social and economic aspirations through excellence in education, research, and leadership.

The Pasifika Undergraduate Scholarships are offered to encourage Pasifika students to undertake and complete undergraduate degree studies at Massey University. Applicants must be enrolled or intend to enrol in an undergraduate degree programme at Massey University, with consideration given to applicants who are involved in the Pasifika community.

Value

The value of the Pasifika Undergraduate Scholarship shall be a **one-off payment** of \$2,000.

Eligibility and conditions

- The Pasifika Undergraduate Scholarships are open to Pasifika students who are enrolled or intending to enrol part time or full time in an undergraduate degree programme in any field or discipline at Massey University.
- The scholarships are open to domestic and international students.
- Applicants who are currently completing the Certificate in Foundation Studies or the Certificate of University Preparation are eligible to apply. Please note:
 - Award of the scholarship will only be made upon successful completion and passing of the relevant preparatory course and;
 - Applicants must enrol in an undergraduate degree programme at Massey University.
- The applicant's short statement on Pasifika community involvement must be accompanied by a reference from a member of the community.
- Consideration will normally only be given to students with a GPA score of 6.0 or better (on a 9 point scale). This is an average grade of B+. However, the decision to award will be at the discretion of the selection committee.
- No Undergraduate Scholarship payment will be made if, for whatever reason, the applicant is not actively involved in his/her degree programme.
- Failure to pass courses for the year of tenure will result in full repayment of the scholarship monies to Massey University by the end of the following year .i.e. if the scholarship is awarded in 2017 and a recipient fails to pass courses during that year, the monies must be repaid in full by the end of 2018.

Term

The Pasifika Undergraduate Scholarship shall be tenable at Massey University for a maximum period of 12 months. No retrospective payments will be permitted beyond this period.

Tenure

The tenure of the Undergraduate Scholarships shall commence within the current year. No deferrals beyond these dates are permitted, except in exceptional circumstances.
