

# Mary Mallon Memorial Scholarship

## Scholarship Regulations

### **Focus**

Human Resource Management.

### **Level of Study**

Postgraduate and Doctoral

### **Purpose**

The Mary Mallon Memorial Scholarship helps New Zealand and international students attain further qualifications to advance their careers in human resource management.

### **Background**

This scholarship was established in memory of Professor Mary Mallon, who died in 2006. She joined Massey University as Professor in Human Resource Management in 2002. Professor Mallon gained her PhD from Sheffield Hallam University in England.

### **Value and Tenure**

The scholarship has a minimum value of \$1,000 for a single academic year.

### **Typical Number on Offer**

One or more Mary Mallon Memorial Scholarships are awarded annually.

### **Eligibility**

Applicants must be enrolled in the year the scholarship is awarded in a thesis of 90 credits or more offered by the School of Management in a topic related to human resource management. Doctoral applicants undertaking research in the area of human resource management are welcome to apply. Applicants can be enrolled at any campus of Massey University.

### **Selection Criteria**

The scholarship is awarded on the basis of academic merit. Consideration will also be given to the nature and costs of the proposed research project.

### **Selection Committee**

The scholarship is awarded by the University Scholarships Selection Committee on the recommendation of the School of Management Research Committee. The University Scholarships Selection Committee has the right to refrain from making an award if there are no suitable applicants and its decision is final.

### **Conditions of the Scholarship**

The scholarship may be held in conjunction with other scholarships, bursaries or awards, so long as those scholarships, bursaries or awards permit co-tenure.
