

# Animal & Plant Health NZ Agricultural Scholarship

## Scholarship Regulations

### **Focus**

Agricultural science, horticultural science and agribusiness

### **Level of Study**

Undergraduate

### **Purpose**

The Animal & Plant Health NZ Agricultural Scholarship supports undergraduate agricultural, horticultural and agribusiness students.

### **Background**

Animal & Plant Health NZ (formally Agcarm) is the peak industry association of companies which manufacture, distribute and sell products that keep animals healthy and crops thriving.

### **Value and Tenure**

The value of a scholarship is \$2,500.

The scholarship is tenable for one year.

### **Typical Number on Offer**

Typically, one scholarship will be awarded per year.

### **Eligibility**

Applicants must:

- be a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident
- be studying full time for a Bachelor of Agricultural Science, Bachelor of Horticultural Science, or Bachelor of Agribusiness at Massey University
- have completed the first year of their degree programme

## **Selection Criteria**

The selection will be based on:

- academic merit
- personal statement
- CV
- a brief (300-500 words) statement which demonstrates the applicant's personal views on the value of agrichemicals to the primary sector

## **Selection Committee**

The scholarship is awarded by the University Scholarships Committee on the recommendation of Animal & Plant Health NZ.

The selection panel has the right to refrain from making an award if there are no suitable applicants.

## **Conditions of the Scholarship**

The scholarship may be held in conjunction with other scholarships, bursaries or awards, so long as those scholarships, bursaries or awards permit co-tenure.
