Scholarship Regulations

Focus

Veterinary science

Level of Study

Undergraduate

Value and Tenure

The value of a scholarship is \$1,500 per year for two years (total of \$3,000).

The scholarship is tenable for two years.

Typical Number on Offer

Typically, one scholarship will be awarded per year.

Eligibility

Applicants must be:

- enrolled full-time in a Bachelor of Veterinary Science at Massey University.
- commencing their fourth year of study.

Selection Criteria

The selection will be based on:

- a written statement on your interests and career intentions. Preference will be given to students who are interested in General Practice with an emphasis on large animal and/or production animal medicine.
- academic results from the previous two years of study.

Selection Committee

The scholarship is awarded by the University Scholarships Committee on the recommendation of the Northern Southland Veterinary Services.

Conditions of the Scholarship

It is expected that the successful candidate shall see practice for a minimum of two weeks with the Northern Southland Veterinary Services sufficient to satisfy the terms of study for the degree of a Bachelor of Veterinary Science. This will be in either their fourth or fifth year at a mutually agreeable time, within the two-year period.

The scholarship will be paid in two instalments; \$1500 in September of the fourth year of study and \$1500 in March of the fifth year of study. The second instalment will be dependant in passing the fourth year of study.

Additional assistance with travel costs to the seeing practice may be available.
