Scholarship Regulations

Focus

Nursing

Level of Study

Undergraduate

Purpose

The Massey University Bachelor of Nursing Scholarship supports second and third year undergraduate students to complete their Bachelor of Nursing degree.

Value and Tenure

The value of the scholarship is \$6,000 and the tenure is for a single academic year for full time second (200 level) or third year (300 level) students only.

Typical Number on Offer

The number of awards available varies depending on the funds.

Eligibility

Applicants must be:

- enrolled full time in the second or third year of the Bachelor of Nursing degree at Massey University
- a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident

Selection Criteria

Selection will be based on academic merit and a 300-word personal statement on career ambitions and societal considerations.

Consideration will be given to students of Māori or Pacific ethnicity, or male students, in recognition of the under representation of these cohorts in the nursing workforce.

Selection Committee

The scholarships will be awarded by the University Scholarships Selection Committee, based on the recommendations of the Head of School of Nursing.

Conditions of the Scholarship

Payment will be made in two equal instalments upon confirmation of full-time enrolment in semesters one and two and following the University's official withdrawal date of these semesters.

Payment of the second instalment is contingent on awardees passing all enrolled course in semester one.

The scholarship may be held in conjunction with other scholarships, bursaries or awards, so long as those scholarships, bursaries or awards permit co-tenure.
