

Anexa Vets Scholarship

Scholarship Regulations

Focus

Veterinary Science

Level of Study

Undergraduate

Purpose

To support Bachelor of Veterinary Science fourth year students who have an interest in large animal production medicine.

Value and Tenure

The total value of the scholarship to the successful annual recipient is \$6,000 and will be paid out over two years.

Typical Number on Offer

Typically, one scholarship will be awarded annually.

Eligibility

Applicants must be:

- studying full time in a Bachelor of Veterinary Science at Massey University
- enrolled in the fourth year of study
- a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident, and normally reside in New Zealand

Selection Criteria

Selection will be based on:

- demonstrated interest in mixed practice with an emphasis on large animal production medicine
- academic results from the previous two years of study
- applicant's CV
- two reference letters

Shortlisted applicants will be invited to attend an interview, held at Massey University with veterinarians from Anexa Vets.

Selection Committee

The grant is awarded by the University Scholarship Selection Committee on the recommendation of Anexa Vets.

Conditions of the Grant

It is expected that the successful candidate shall see practice with Anexa Vets for one week in their fourth year and for another week in their fifth year. These two weeks are over and above the week of Externship that they may spend with Anexa Vets.

Receipt of the second year of the award is dependant on the recipient passing the fourth year of study.

This scholarship may be held concurrently with any other scholarship, bursary, or award, provided this is not considered to constitute a conflict of interest.
