## Scholarship Regulations

### Focus

Food Technology

### Level of Study

Undergraduate

### Purpose

The FoodHQ Food Technology is to support students with a passion for food technology study the Bachelor of Food Technology (Honours) at Massey University.

### Background

The Central Economic Development Agency (CEDA) connects people, place and business in Manawātū. Working closely with our partners, stakeholders and wider business community, CEDA's core objectives, programmes and activities are designed to create the environment, stimulus, outcomes and impacts that power economic prosperity for the region and beyond.

FoodHQ Innovation is New Zealand's leading hub of food and food production scientists that advocates for collaboration, food innovation and investment among researchers, industry, and policymakers to tackle challenges to advance the food industry

### Value and Tenure

The value of the award is \$5,000 per annum for up to four years. The scholarship may be used towards covering the costs of study.

## Typical Number on Offer

Typically, one award is available annually.

## Eligibility

Applicants must be:

- a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident
- enrolling full-time in the first year of the Bachelor of Food Technology with Honours

## Selection Criteria

Selection will be based on a statement of no more than 1000 words that demonstrates a passion for food technology, career prospects in the industry, and academic merit.

## Selection Committee

The scholarship is awarded by the University Scholarships Selection Committee on the recommendation of a panel consisting of FoodHQ and CEDA representatives.

## Conditions of the Scholarship

Continuation of the award will be contingent upon academic performance in each year, with an expectation that scholarship students maintain an overall grade point average (GPA) of 5 (B) to continue to receive the scholarship monies.

Recipients of the scholarship are expected to consent to their information being shared on Massey University. FoodHQ and CEDA communication platforms for the purpose of profiling the scholarship programme and sharing their stories.

This scholarship is not normally able to be held in conjunction with other scholarships, bursaries or awards. Co-tenure may only be approved at the discretion of the selection committee.
