Purpose

The Good Wool Hunting Textile Design Scholarship supports students with a passion for spinning, weaving or knitting who are studying a Bachelor of Design at Massey University.

Background

Good Wool Hunting is a retailer of NZ and imported yarns. We are less than a 5-minute drive out of Greytown, in the Wairarapa. We love crafting with natural fibres - spinning, weaving, knitting and crocheting. We also dye yarn with natural dyes and with acid dyes under the brand Greytown Fibre Co. with yarn sourced from New Zealand and abroad. Good Wool Hunting values the mental health benefits that come from crafting and would like to encourage others to develop a love of crafting with fibre as well.

Value and Tenure

The value of the scholarship is up to \$5,000 to be paid towards the tuition fees. The tenure is for one year.

Typical Number on Offer

Typically, one scholarship is available annually.

Eligibility

Applicants must be:

- enrolled in the Bachelor of Design or Bachelor of Design (Honours), majoring in Textile Design at Massey University
- entering the second year of the degree

- be enrolled or intending to enrol in the following courses in the year of scholarship tenure:
 - 223.263 Textile Design 2.1: Knitted Textiles and,
 - 223.265 Textile Design 2.3: Woven Textiles

Selection Criteria

Selection will be based on the academic merit of the first year of study in the Bachelor of Design, with applicants expected to have a minimum B+ average in their first year.

A portfolio of 10 items demonstrating participation in at least one of the following crafts: spinning, weaving, knitting, or crocheting.

Selection Committee

Selection will be made by the University Scholarships Selection Committee on the recommendation of a panel from School of Design, Toi Rauwhāangi College of Creative Arts.

Conditions of the Scholarship

The tuition fee payment will be made into the Massey University Student Fee account.

Should the cost of the tuition fees be less than \$5,000 the scholarship value will be adjusted to reflect the lower amount.

The scholarship may be held in conjunction with other scholarships, bursaries, or awards, so long as those scholarships, bursaries, or awards permit co-tenure.
