

# Massey University Return to Study Scholarship

## Scholarship Regulations

### Focus

Returners

### Level of Study

Undergraduate

### Purpose

The Massey University Return to Study Scholarship supports high achieving undergraduate students return to study following a break.

### Value and Tenure

The value of the scholarship is up to \$3,500 to be dispersed as follows:

- Direct payment to the recipient of \$3,000 for full time students (enrolled in 60 credits in semester two) and \$1,500 for students studying part time (minimum 30 credits in semester two).
- Support through the Scholars Massey programme of up to the value of \$500

The tenure is for semester two of the year of application.

### Typical Number on Offer

Multiple scholarships will be offered.

### Eligibility

Applicants must:

- be New Zealand citizens or permanent residents
- be intending to enrol in an undergraduate degree at Massey University in semester two
- have completed a minimum of 120 credits towards an undergraduate degree at Massey University
- have not been enrolled at Massey University in semester one of the scholarship application year

## **Selection Criteria**

Selection will be based on academic merit. Applicants are normally expected to have achieved a minimum B+ grade average in their Massey University study to date.

The applicant's undergraduate degree, campus, study load, and time to completion may be taken into consideration when making the selection.

Consideration of personal characteristics, including cultural identity, background and experience, will be given to ensure that equity outcomes are achieved.

## **Selection Committee**

Selection will be made by the University Scholarships Selection Committee.

## **Conditions of the Scholarship**

The scholarship may be held in conjunction with other scholarships, bursaries or awards, so long as these permit co-tenure.

Payment will be made in one instalment following Massey University's official withdrawal date without financial penalty in semester two.

Successful recipients will be required to hold a New Zealand bank account in order to receive payment.
