Level of Study

Undergraduate

Purpose

The Massey University Food Technology Undergraduate Scholarship supports students entering the first year of the Bachelor of Food Technology (Honours).

Value and Tenure

The value of the scholarship is up to \$6,000 to be dispersed as follows:

- direct payment to the recipient of \$5,000 to
- support through the Scholars Massey programme up to the value of \$1,000

The tenure is one year.

Typical Number on Offer

The number of scholarships will be determined based on available funding, with multiple awards offered annually.

Eligibility

Applicants will be:

- a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident
- intending to enrol in the first year of a Bachelor of Food Technology (Honours) at Massey University in the year following the award

Selection Criteria

The selection will be based on evidence of academic achievement as demonstrated in NCEA level 2 or equivalent secondary school results to date.

Consideration of personal characteristics, including cultural identity, background, and experience, will be given to ensure that equity outcomes are achieved.

Selection Committee

The scholarship will be selection by the University Scholarships Selection Committee on the recommendation of a panel including staff from the School of Food Technology and Natural Sciences, Massey University.

Conditions of the Scholarship

Recipients will join the Scholars Massey community. This community offers advice and support on scholar development through activities and events, alongside peer mentoring opportunities.

These scholarships are no co-tenable with the Massey University Undergraduate First Year Scholarship – School Leavers, the He Oha Puiaki Massey University Māori First Year Scholarship, or the Massey University Academy of Sport First Year Scholarship, but may be held in conjunction with other scholarships, bursaries and awards.

The payment will be paid in two equal instalments following Massey University's official withdrawal date without financial penalty in semesters one and two.
