

Nursing Bursary for Postgraduate Study

Bursary Regulations

Focus

Registered Nurses (RN)

Level of Study

Postgraduate

Purpose

The Nursing Bursary for Postgraduate Study supports newly graduated registered nurses and registered nurses to undertake postgraduate study by reducing financial barriers.

Value and Tenure

The value of the bursary is \$500, and the tenure is one semester.

Typical Number on Offer

Multiple bursaries are available.

Eligibility

Applicants must be:

- a Registered Nurse (RN) with a current Annual Practising Certificate (APC)
- working in a New Zealand Health and Disability service/organisations
- enrolled or intending to enrol into course 168.733 Physiology & Pathophysiology

Selection Criteria

Selection will be based on financial need and the benefit of the bursary to the recipient.

Selection Committee

Selection will be made on recommendation from the School of Nursing panel to the University Scholarships Selection Committee.

Conditions of the Bursary

The bursary can be held in conjunction with other scholarships, bursaries or awards, so long as these permit co-tenure.
