Joan Berry Fellowships in Veterinary Science - Postgraduate

Fellowship Regulations

Focus Veterinary Science

Level of Study Postgraduate

Purpose

To assist students in pursuing a postgraduate degree or diploma directed towards research into animal health and welfare

Value and Tenure

The fellowships shall be awarded annually and shall have a value of up to \$8,500 per annum.

The amount may vary depending upon the available income. The fellowship is tenable for one year.

Typical Number on Offer

Typically, one fellowship will be awarded per year

Eligibility

Applicants must be postgraduate veterinary science students enrolled in a postgraduate degree or diploma. Students with a particular interest in promoting animal health and welfare are encouraged to apply.

Selection Criteria

Selection will be based on academic merit. Financial need will also be considered.

Selection Panel

The fellowship is awarded by the University Scholarships Committee on the recommendation of the School of Veterinary Sciences.

The University Scholarships Committee has the right to refrain from making an award if there are no suitable applicants and its decision is final.

Conditions of the Fellowship

A proportion of any fellowship may be used to support the research of the recipient, this being nominated at the time of the award. The fellowship may be held in conjunction with other awards
