Level of Study

Undergraduate

Purpose

The Massey University Mathematics Scholarship supports students who are interested in studying mathematics.

Value and Tenure

The value of the scholarship is determined each year from the interest earned on the capital. Usually, this is approximately \$2,500.

The scholarship is tenable for one year.

Typical Number on Offer

Typically, one scholarship will be awarded per year.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- be enrolled full time or part time (a minimum of 60 credits in the year of tenure), by internal or distance study mode, in either the Bachelor of Science or Bachelor of Arts degree, majoring in mathematics at 100 level.
- express a desire to continue their study of mathematics

Selection Criteria

The selection will be based on:

- achievement in any 100 level mathematics courses, such as 160.101 or 160.102
- demonstrated desire to continue studying mathematics

Selection Committee

The scholarship is awarded by the University Scholarships Selection Committee based on recommendations from the Head of School of the School of Mathematical and Computational Sciences, Massey University.

Conditions of the Scholarship

The scholarship may be held concurrently with any other bursaries or scholarship, provided that the rules of the other award allow this.

On occasion this scholarship may be split between two equally deserving candidates.

The Committee may decline to award any scholarships in any given year if there are no applicants of sufficient merit to warrant an award.

At the discretion of the University, all, or part, of the annual interest may be reinvested in order to maintain the value of the capital fund or the value of the award for subsequent years.
