

# Te Aroha Vets Veterinary Grant

## Grant Regulations

### **Focus**

Veterinary Science

### **Level of Study**

Undergraduate

### **Purpose**

The purpose of the Te Aroha Vets Veterinary Grant is to support 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> year Bachelor of Veterinary Science students in seeing mixed practice.

### **Background**

Te Aroha Vets is a private practice operating in the Waikato for 40 years. It is a family focused, mixed practice with a strong dairy component to the work. Te Aroha Vets has a growing, well-equipped, and recently refurbished small animal department with a team that is passionate about providing an excellent standard of care.

### **Value and Tenure**

The grant value is \$1,000 and the tenure is one year.

### **Typical Number on Offer**

Typically, two grants will be awarded.

### **Eligibility**

Applicants must be currently enrolled full time in the fourth or fifth year of the Bachelor of Veterinary Science at Massey University. Applicants should have a particular interest in working in mixed animal practice and be willing to see practice at Te Aroha Veterinary Services.

### **Selection Criteria**

Selection is based on a written statement on the applicants interests and career intentions. Academic merit may also be taken into consideration.

**Selection Committee**

The grants will be awarded at the discretion of the Directors of Te Aroha Veterinary Services.

**Conditions of the Bursary**

Recipients will be expected to see practice at Te Aroha Veterinary Services during the award year.

Payment will be made as a lump sum upon seeing practice.
