

School of Mathematical and Computational Sciences Summer Scholarship

Scholarship Regulations

Focus

Summer Scholarships across the subject areas of Computer Science, Data Science, Information Technology, Mathematics, Statistics.

Level of Study

Undergraduate or Postgraduate

Purpose

The School of Mathematical and Computational Sciences' summer scholarships support students who wish to undertake supervised research over the summer period.

Value and Tenure

The value of each scholarship is \$6,000.

The tenure of each scholarship will be for a minimum of ten weeks, the commencement date to be negotiated between the successful applicant and his/her supervisor and will terminate before the start of Semester One of the following year.

Typical Number on Offer

Typically, ten scholarships, across the above subject areas.

Eligibility

The scholarships are available to both domestic and international students currently enrolled at Massey University.

Applicants must be:

- undertaking a major in one of the subject areas listed above, or an equivalent.

- either enrolled in an undergraduate degree (with anticipated completion of at least 200-level in their majoring subject(s) by the end of the year of application), or be currently enrolled in a postgraduate qualification, or have recently completed the requirements for an appropriate Bachelor or Postgraduate degree.

Selection Criteria

Selection will be based on:

- academic merit
- an indication of the type of project the applicant is interested in (a willingness to be involved in a range of projects would be helpful)
- CV
- a personal statement on why the applicant wishes to undertake research and what their intentions are beyond this summer research

The applicant's interest and passion for research will also be taken into consideration .

Selection Committee

The scholarship is awarded by the University Scholarship Selection Committee on the recommendation of the Head of School for the School of Mathematical and Computational Sciences, and the School Research Lead.

Conditions of the Scholarship

Each successful applicant is required to submit a report of their research to their supervisor at the conclusion of their scholarship.

Payment will be made in three equal instalments with the final payment being conditional upon receipt of the research report.
