

Wireless Network Configuration Guide Android 10+

Most Android versions since 10 follow these steps to connect to a Massey network

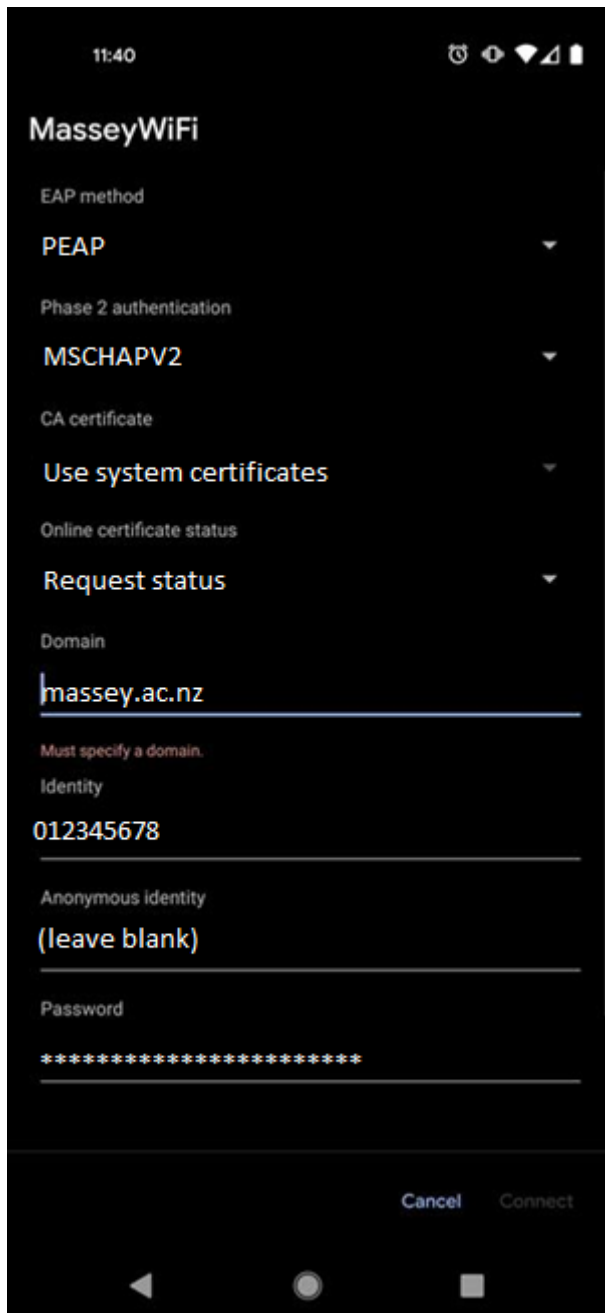
Network Access

All users connecting to the network require Massey credentials.

- **Students:** Student ID + Password

- **Staff:** Usercode + Password

The password used is your **network password**, not Portal password



1. Turn on your Wi-Fi. Then select **MasseyWiFi**
2. Select **PEAP** under *EAP method*
3. Select **MSCHAPV2** under the *Phase 2 authentication* heading
4. Under *CA certificate*, select **Use system certificates**
5. Under *Online certificate status*, select **Request status**
6. Under *domain*, enter **massey.ac.nz**
7. Enter your **Student ID** [or **Usercode**] into the *Identity* box
8. Leave the *Anonymous identity* box blank
9. Enter your **Password** into the *Password* box
10. Tap **Connect** and you're done! 😊

If you are unable to see the *Phase 2 authenticate* option, there may be an option to select additional options. If you cannot access Use system certificates under the CA certificate option, use the Android instructions on the back of this sheet.

Most Android versions since 3.1 follow these steps to connect to a Massey network


Network Access

11. Turn on your Wi-Fi. Then select **MasseyWiFi**

12. Select **PEAP** under *EAP method*

13. Select **MSCHAPV2** under the *Phase 2 authentication* heading

14. Under *CA certificate*, select **Do not validate**

15. Enter your **Student ID** [or **Usercode**] into the *Identity* box

16. Leave the *Anonymous identity* box blank

17. Enter your **Password** into the *Password* box

18. Tap **Connect** and you're done! 😊
